Cancellation

If you enroll in camp and your plans change, you can receive a full credit/refund for camp tuition, less registration fee. **Program change/cancellation requests must be received thirty days prior to enrolled camp week start date.** Program change requests received 15 days prior to enrolled camp week start date will receive a 50% refund, less registration fee. Participants who do not attend their registered camp week or who do not contact us 15 days prior to their start date will not receive a refund or credit. We do not give partial refunds for missed camp days for any reason. Any credits must be used during the 2026 camp session.

In the event that a minimum enrollment is not met, we reserve the right to cancel or reschedule a camp. If this happens, you will be notified at least 7 days in advance and full tuition will be refunded less the non-refundable fee; we will do our best to find another camp option.

Allergy and Asthma Action Plan

If your child has a food allergy and/or asthma, please make sure to work with camp staff to have an action plan in place prior to the beginning of camp. Apply sunscreen to your child prior to coming to camp every morning and provide a hat they may wear during outside play time (please label the hat with your child's name). Hats and sunglasses optional, but always a really, really great idea - labeled, of course!

Prohibited Food Items

L'Etoile is nut free during the summer. If you send your child to camp with a nut butter alternative, please make sure the item is labeled. Depending on the severity of allergies of enrolled campers, additional foods may be prohibited and you will be notified in the logistics email sent before the start of camp.

Potty Training Requirements and Nap Time

Children in our youngest camps must be potty trained per L'Etoile policy. Three year olds must be existing students, students enrolled for the 2026-2027 school year, or receive an exception from the [Summer Camp Director](#). Nap time is not available.

What To Bring

1. Bag or Backpack

- Every camper should bring a sturdy bag or backpack to store their belongings each day.

2. **Water Bottle**

- A refillable water bottle labeled with your child's name. Glass water bottles are not permitted.

3. **Lunch and Snack**

- Campers should bring a lunch and a morning snack every day. Those staying for after care should bring an afternoon snack. We cannot reheat or refrigerate any lunches. No glass water bottles or containers.
- Pack lunch and snacks in containers that are easy for your child to open and close independently. Please provide silverware and napkins for your child.

4. **Clothing**

- Dress your camper in weather-appropriate, comfortable play clothes and shoes. Sneakers are required for sports camps.
- Pack a sweater or light jacket for cooler mornings or unexpected changes in weather.

5. **Bathing Suit & Towel**

- **Water Days:** Campers should bring a bathing suit and towel on Mondays to leave at camp for the week. Water days will typically be on Fridays, with the possibility of an additional day depending on the weather.
- **Bathing Suit & Towel - labeled** with your child's name.

Label Everything!

To help keep track of your camper's belongings, **everything not physically attached to your child must be labeled including:**

- Water bottles
- Lunch containers, reusable silverware etc
- Sweaters or jackets
- Bathing suits and towels
- Hats, Sunglasses

Unlabeled items are easily misplaced, and labels help us return them to the rightful owners. Thank you for your cooperation in helping us keep camp organized and ensuring your camper is prepared for a fantastic summer!
